With the technical skill and vocal range of a legitimate lyric soprano, she performed many styles from popular standards to operatic arias.

South Pacific is a musical composed by Richard Rodgers and lyrics by Oscar Hammerstein II. The work premiered on Broadway in 1949 and was an immediate hit, running for 1,925 performances. Songs included in the broadcast: I'm Gonna Wash That Man Right Outa My Hair, There is Nothin' Like a Dame and Some Enchanted Evening.
