

Famous Australians



Betty Cuthbert AC, MBE, was born in Sydney, on 20 April, 1938 and passed away in 2017.

Nicknamed the Australian "Golden Girl", Betty Cuthbert won three Olympic Gold Medals (100m, 200m and 4 x 100m relay) at the 1956 Olympic Games in Melbourne and one Olympic Gold Medal (400m) at the 1964 Tokyo Olympics.

Throughout her running career, Betty Cuthbert set world record times for 60m, 100 yards, 200m, 220 yards and 440 yards. She received countless sporting awards and even has a rose named after her. Cuthbert was an important player in the

creation of **MS Research Australia** and she was a tireless campaigner for raising awareness of the disease.

Easter Parade

Songs from the musical, *Easter Parade,* will be broadcast on Thursday, 17 April at 2pm (AEST) & 1.30pm (ACST)

Easter Parade was released in 1948 and was a box office success. It was the second most popular musical of the 1940s. The film starred **Judy Garland** and **Fred Astaire** with music written by **Irving Berlin.**

Popular songs from the film include *Steppin' Out with my Baby*, *Shakin' the Blues Away* and the title song, *Easter Parade*.
