# International Coffee Day




### **World Food Day**

Helen Reddy was born in Melbourne on 25 October 1941 and passed away in 2020. She was born into a show business family and started as an entertainer from the age of four.

In 1966, Reddy appeared on *Bandstand* and won a ticket to the USA for a recording audition. In the 1970s, Reddy achieved international chart success, in particular in the USA with 15 singles in the top 40.

Helen Reddy retired from performing live in 2002 and then went on to complete a degree. She returned to live performance in 2011 to the delight of many fans and will always be remembered for her signature hit song "I am Woman".
